1/22 WERE CLOTH (NYLON)

20/22 WERE PLASTIC (1 Roth's, 1 table cloth, 2 trash bags, 16 Fred Meyer bags)

1/22 WAS PAPER

### • OF THE 22 PARACHUTES WITH THE SLOWEST SPEEDS

11/22 USED 4 STRINGS

10/22 USED 6 STRINGS

1/22 USED 5 STRINGS

### • 1/22 HAD A HOLE IN THE CENTER OF THE CANOPY

### • OF THE 22 PARACHUTES WITH THE SLOWEST SPEED

8/22 WERE CIRCLES

6/22 WERE SQUARES

1/22 WAS A HEXAGON SHAPES

• 7/22 WERE RECTANGLES

## COMBINATIONS THAT HAD THE SLOWEST SPEEDS

— 1/22 WAS CLOTH (nylon), 4-STRINGS, CIRCLE

( 1/22 had a hole in the center of the canopy)

— 1/22 PLASTIC (trash bag), 4-STRINGS, SQUARE

— 2/22 PLASTIC, 4-STRINGS, CIRCLE (1 Thriftway, 1 Fred Meyer)

-- 5/22 PLASTIC, 6-STRINGS, CIRCLE (1 trash bag, 4 Fred Meyer)

— 1/22 PLASTIC, 5-STRINGS, CIRCLE

— 3/22 PLASTIC, 6-STRINGS, SQUARE

— 1/22 PLASTIC, 6-STRINGS, HEXAGON

-- 5/22 PLASTIC, 4-STRINGS, RECTANGLE [1 table cloth, (2) 30 x 60

(2) 30 x 40 cm

— 2/22 PLASTIC, 6-STRINGS, RECTANGLE

-- 1/22 PAPER, 4-STRINGS, CIRCLE
